Currently, we have a request for (60) quilts for young people living at Bethany Children's Home. Our goal is to complete all the machine sewn quilts by the middle of December in order to present our gifts to the young people for Christmas. We are bringing our portable sewing machines every week and sewing various quilt patterns.

Our meetings are held <u>every</u> Saturday of the month starting at 1:00 PM. It is a time of fun, fellowship and a time to relax after a busy or stressful week. If you are unable to join us, you may make these items at home, bring them to church or give your gift to anyone participating in our outreach program.

Shawl materials (yarn and needles) and quilting materials are available and will be provided to those willing to join in our ministry. We also have many types of looms for those seeking a new challenge, rather than learning to knit or crochet.

FISHER/McCONNELL SCHOLARSHIP ATTENDANCE/SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

The following criteria will apply to all Junior and Senior high school students who are members of Trinity United Church of Christ and are planning to apply for the Fisher/McConnell/Johnson Scholarship.

- 1. Current Juniors will attend the Sunday morning worship service at least once a month during their Junior and Senior years beginning with the month of June following the completion of the Sophomore year of high school.
- *** There will be a sign-up sheet in the narthex to record attendance.
- 2. Students must complete (10) hours of service to the Church each year. Suggested activities include: Lector, Usher, Greeter, Acolyte, Crucifer, VBS Assistant, Chimer, outside spring clean-up, special music, Sunday School teacher or assistant, and Nursery attendant. Projects are not limited to those listed. Students must complete a total of (20) hours during the Junior and Senior years.
- ***Please note: Any Service on any given Sunday will complete a (1) hour requirement.
- 3. Recipients must be present at the church service following high school graduation to accept the scholarship. Failure to do so may result in forfeiting the scholarship for the current year. Application will have to be completed during the following year.

Church World Service Blankets + Sunday October 5, 2014

 Through fishing boats that are helping fishermen like Ahmad Syarif build sustainable livelihoods and provide for their families.

Using boats provided with the help of CWS, Ahmad Syarif and fellow members of the Tolong Menolong Fishers Group have strengthened both their earning potential and their resilience.

Here at Trinity, we continue to participate with the Blankets + Program. Our goal each year is to send \$1000.00. Our Joyful Noise offerings help us to meet our goal, but the majority of the money comes from you. A blanket costs \$5.00, how many can you afford to send?

This special offering will be collected on Sunday, October 5, 2014. Checks should be made out to to Trinity UCC so we can send the money with one check, that way, our church gets the credit for the donation and you get credit for a donation to the church.
