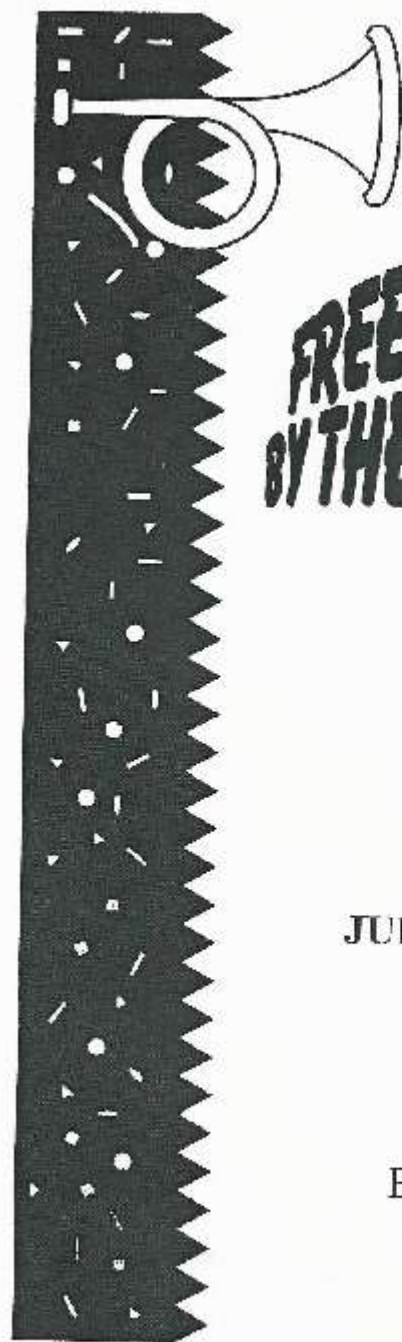

Frequently Asked Questions



What is it? An outdoor, multi media experience where the participant walks a designated route through the streets of Tamaqua, observing their transformed town in a new way. (Kind of like a parade in reverse, where the audience moves instead of the performers.) The whole experience takes 45-60 minutes, depending on how long you stay at each location.

How do I get in? On August 4th between 7:30-8:30pm a line will form outside the Train Station (Vonz Restaurant). Look for volunteers in bright yellow shirts and signs to guide you! Every few minutes a group of 25 audience members will begin the one-mile multimedia walking experience together.

Is there a cost? Nope, it's FREE!! A big thank you to our supporters.

Where can I park? We suggest you walk down if you can, but if you need to drive, parking (at your own risk) is available from 6-11pm at Tamaqua Family Practice medical lot and between Fegley's (Valero) gas station and Auto Zone (overflow lot). Street parking is also available throughout town.

Are there restrooms? Port-o-pottie locations: St. John Paul Parish XXIII parking lot and Tamaqua Train Station. In house bathrooms available at Tamaqua Adult Day Care, Tamaqua Community Art Center and Vonz Restaurant.

What if it rains? In the event of inclement weather, the Rain Date is August 5th. If there is inclement weather on both dates, the experience will be canceled. Call the Tamaqua Community Arts Center 570-668-1192 or check the Dear Tamaqua face book page after 4pm on August 5th for details.

Walking concerns? The experience is one-mile long and moves at your own pace; the majority of the route is handicap accessible, but one block is not. Ask a volunteer when you arrive for an alternate route map! Comfortable shoes are recommended.

What about the Grand Finale? At approximately 9:30pm the Grand Finale will begin at the Train Station. Bring lawn chairs or blankets and set up camp ahead of time. You can check in your chairs at the Tamaqua Ambulance station prior to you enjoying Dear Tamaqua, the Kidz Karnival, or National Night Out, and collect them before the finale. Drop off times 4:30pm; collection no later than 9:30pm. Not responsible for lost or missing chairs left after this time.

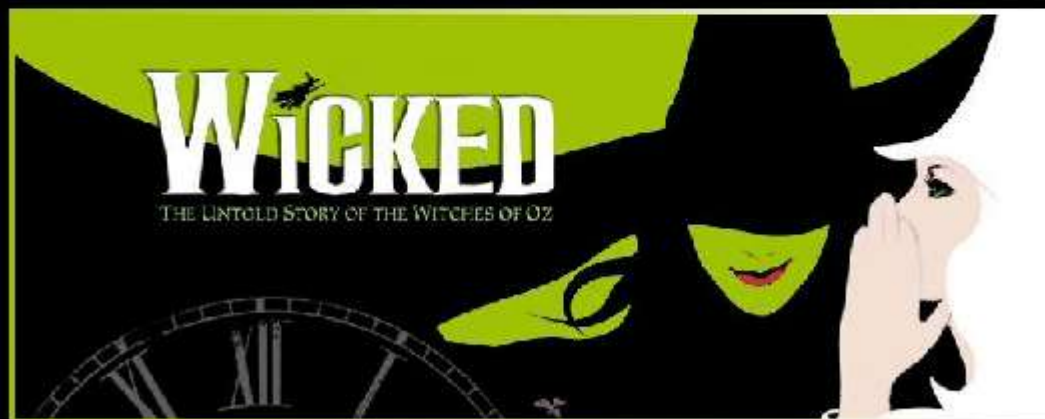

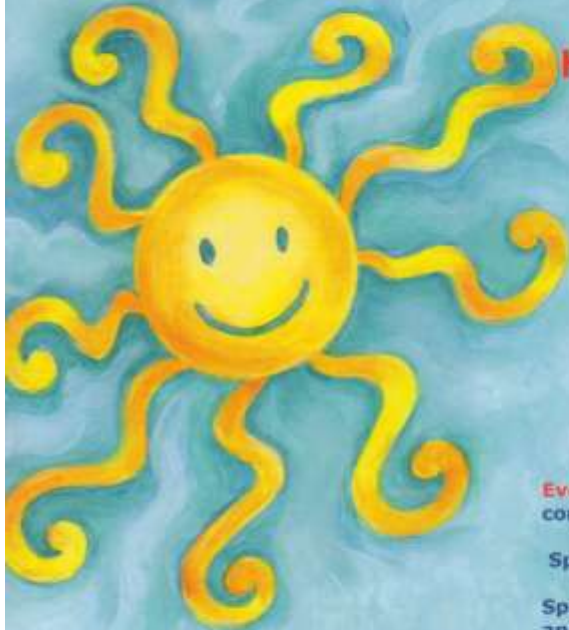
