TAMAQUA CHAMBER OFFERS INFORMATIONAL PROGRAM ON EMBEZZLEMENT PREVENTION

Everyday there are newspaper stories about how some dishonest employee or an officer of a youth sports organization or a non-profit organization has managed to divert funds into his or her own pocket. It is a subject that every business owner or organization should give serious thought to learning how to prevent it.

That's what the Tamaqua Chamber hopes to do at a Breakfast program, sponsored by Schuylkill County District Attorney Christine Holman, and Rich Shupp, of President of Cloud Service Center, with locations in Tamaqua and Emmaus. The program will begin with Rich Shupp, a Certified QuickBooks Pro Advisor, demonstrating how to locate discrepancies in QuickBooks that can be used to misappropriate funds.

PA. State Trooper Bernard J. Walasavage will discuss the preliminary investigation and the use of subpoenas and search warrants to assist with gathering all types of records and evidence and obtaining the initial interviews to move the case forward. In addition, Trooper Walasavage will discuss the aspects of obtaining a forensic audit. Trooper Walasavage has been employed by the PA State Police for 25 years and has been assigned to the Schuylkill Haven criminal investigation unit for last 10 years, and has also served as an alternate forensic services unit member.

Finally, Schuylkill County District Attorney Christine Holman will discuss how to prevent fraud in sports organizations and non-profit organization along with how embezzlement cases are prosecuted. Attorney Christine Holman is a Schuylkill County resident and a graduate of North Schuylkill High School and Penn State University. In 1991, she received her Juris Doctor from the Thomas M. Cooley Law School in Lansing, Michigan. Her career includes clerking for many well-known Schuylkill County judges, and as the lead prosecutor for the Juvenile Division in the County DA's office. She opened her own private practice in Frackville, specializing in criminal defense, family law and personal injury. Prior to being elected as District Attorney, Christine served as an Assistant County Solicitor for two years.

This important and informative breakfast program will be held from 8:00 am to 9:00 am on November 10, 2015, at the Tamaqua Arts Center. A continental breakfast will be provided. Chamber members as well as non-Chamber members are encouraged to attend. Reservations are required to attend.


